A NOTE FROM THE CEO

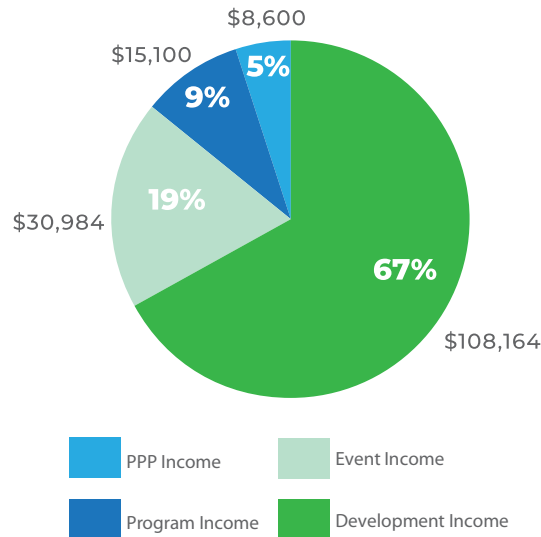

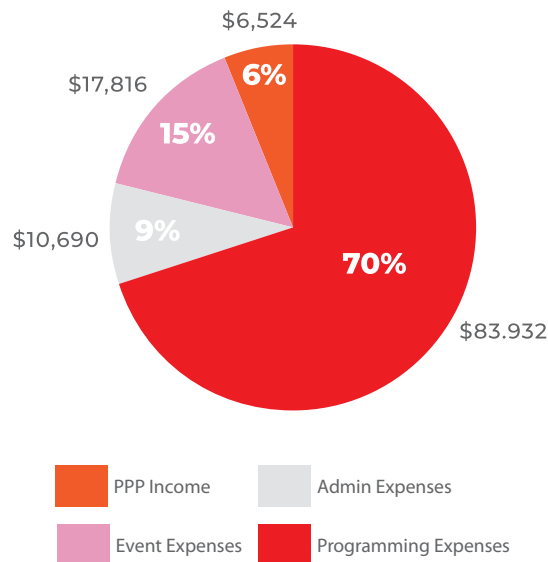
